# Creating a Story

### Due Date:

In this exercise you will create a story and a storyboard to be used when we are learning the various areas of video creation. The story can be from your own imagination, but you are limited by the school rules and regulations. Thus the following guidelines are for you to follow:

### Guidelines:

1. No violence having to do with any living creature or anything that represents a living creature.
2. Language must be appropriate to the school classroom.
3. Nothing should be in the story that depicts drug or alcohol usage.
4. Anything that depicts an encouragement of any criminal behavior is not appropriate.
5. Nothing of a pornographic or sexual nature.
6. Anything that is a put down of a person and/or group of persons is not allowed.
7. Can not use any previously made movies unless you clear it with your instructor. It will depend on the circumstance whether you will be allowed to use other movies. There are some copyright restrictions that we must follow as well.
8. No imagery that would go against school or class rules.

**Work Groups:** You may work in groups for this or individually. No more than 3 people to a group. During the production of the video each members contribution will need to be documented. Work with your group to come up with a story that has the following requirements:

### Requirements:

1. Must be able to be produced locally. Either on campus or in the local area. Don't create a story that takes place in an impossible to get to place like "Death Valley".
2. The length of the story should be from 10+ seconds per person (3 people = 30 sec).
3. Must have at least one animated character per person in the group.
4. This is not the script so we want a short description of the story.
