



Architectural Photography Project

Objective: For this project you will do some research on Architectural Photography and then produce 4 quality architectural photos. Two of the photos will be shots outdoors and two will be interior shots.

Technical Requirements:

1. Use the Digital Rebels (or equivalent). For those that want to check out the Digital Rebel to take home you must have a Digital Camera Contract signed by your parent/guardian.
2. Use lenses that will be best for the area that you intend to photograph. For example you may need to use one of the wide angle lenses for the interior shots.
3. Create a "Contact" sheet of all your "keeper" images.
4. Create 3 -7.5X10 images. Use the "Camera Raw" knowledge you learned about to make any adjustments that are needed to make the image quality better
5. Print out the images using the best settings.
6. Mat one of the images that you believe is the best. The matted images will be hung up on the wall.
7. Incorporate the human element with in the shots.
8. Shoot in Camera Raw
9. Use of lighting for emphasis of the architecture.

Other Requirements:

1. Write using the Memo Style that you learned in your answer the following:
 - a. What type of Architecture photography did you find to be the most difficult ?
 - b. What equipment modifications did you make for this project? Example what lenses did you use to emphasize the subject better.
 - c. What were the challenges for doing this type of photography?
