



## Sports Photography Project

**Objective:** For this project you will do some research on Sports Photography and then produce 3 quality photos dealing with a sport. Do research on the internet. Especially try to find information about the particular sport that you are going to photograph. Find out such things as the following:

1. Best location to photograph from
2. What equipment would be good to use.
3. What things would be considered in poor taste to shoot or equipment not to use.
4. What s did you have to consider about the sport that you chose to photograph.

### Technical Requirements:

1. Use the Digital Rebels (or equivalent). For those that want to check out the Digital Rebel to take home you must have a Digital Camera Contract signed by your parent/guardian.
2. Use lenses that will be best for the type of Nature you intend to photograph
3. Create a "Contact" sheet of all your "keeper" images.
4. Create 3 7.5X10 images. Use the "Camera Raw" knowledge you learned about to make any adjustments that are needed to make the image quality better. Images will be printed out a 7.5x10 (or as close as possible) of their best shot.
5. Mat one of the images that you believe is the best. The matted images will be hung up on the wall where it says "Commercial Class".
6. Quality exposure
7. Shutter speed settings and the effects from using different shutter speeds.

### Other Requirements:

1. Write using the Memo Style that you learned in your answer the following:
  - a. Type out the information that you found in your research from the things suggested in the Objective part of this handout.
  - b. What equipment modifications did you make for this project ?
  - c. What were the challenges for doing this type of photography?
