The grade for this project will be based 70% on your technical ability to get the site to work properly, 10% for using Tables or Frames to build the website, and 10% for using some Flash Animation on the website. The other 10% is for a write up that you will do for the project.

Requirements:

Technical Ability (70% 35 pts):

- a. Local Root Folder- "YourName.DWProject". **EVERYTHING** must be in the LRF.
- b. Files and Folders organized and named correctly.
- c. Photos used for the site should be in the "Images folder."
- e. Site requirements-
 1. At least 5 pages in the site.
 2. Opening page called "**index.htm**" located at the root of the LRF.
 3. At least one photo or image on each page. Background image not included.
 4. Every page has to have a "links" to all of the other pages.
 5. A link to the current PHS website on the "Home" page.
 6. Each page must be titled on the Title Bar.
 7. Must be some text of a different color.
 8. Must use a background color or background image on each page.
 9. Must change the link colors to a non-default color and have a different clicked color as well.
 10. A Heading must be used somewhere within the site.
 11. Text Style used somewhere in site like **Bold** or *Italic*.
 12. Rollover buttons for links to the other pages.

13. Code documents for each page should be in the LRF in appropriate folder.
14. Site works on Mr. R's computer

Using Tables or Frames to build the website (10% 5 pts):

The web pages must be designed using either Frames or Tables as the main design element for each page.

Flash Animation (10% 5 pts):

At least one flash animation within the website and in the "Flash" folder.

Write up (10% 5 pts):

Using the Memo style that you learned for the previous project answer the following questions.

1. Did you use Frames or Tables to design the project and give your reasons for your choice that you made?
2. What did you find to be easier when using Dreamweaver instead of HTML coding?
3. What did you find more difficult with Dreamweaver than HTML coding?
